**CPCS Plant Assessments** - in all plant and machinery, including, dumpers, rollers, excavators, 360% wheeled and tracked, forklift, slinger/signallers.

The Plant & Vehicle Marshal training course is accepted by C Skills, to be adopted as a CPCS carded category which is the largest and most highly recognised card scheme for the plant industry.
